Over the past year, more than 5,000 workers have lost their jobs in the nation's newspaper industry, and rapid changes are taking place that may accelerate this trend. In Honolulu, the *Honolulu Advertiser* has begun layoffs, and employees have been unsuccessful in bargaining for a new contract.

Mr. Lunzer recently took over the helm of THG-CWA, a newspaper union with more than 30,000 members. He champions the "development of ownership and revenue models that work" and says that "layoffs and less content, along with less diversity, will only lead to failure." He also recognizes the need to include all media workers in new organizing drives and the importance of media workers to a robust democracy.
